



### **“Select Reserve” Locker Membership Details**

- Upon sign up and payment, members will be requested to make a username and password for the Preserve website. You will need to sign in to access the members only portal and online store.
- You will be onboarded and issued a physical card that will be available upon your next visit. This card is not necessary to have in your possession if you opt-in to connect directly to your credit card of choice.
- By default you will be added to the following systems; RESY reservation system, TOAST pos system, WEBSITE online locker Tour. If you'd like to remain anonymous please let us know and we can accommodate your needs.
- Preserve will set aside tables for Priority seating. These will be filled on a member first come first served. We still would love it if you let us know you are coming via reservations but this feature is for last minute reservations so you won't be out in the cold on a busy night.

- Locker Members are encouraged to pick up their bottles at the quarterly pickup parties. However if you cannot make the events, you can arrange pickup by making a reservation via telephone at (530) 795-9963.
- Please note that all Memberships are pre-paid and require a credit card number to be kept on file. Memberships are renewed automatically on the last business day of each month and can be canceled at any time. Reopened memberships that have expired are considered new and are subject to availability.
- Members are encouraged to keep their contact and credit card information up-to-date. If we are unable to contact a member or process a payment before the membership expires, the membership will be terminated.
- While we provide a lock and key for all lockers, the Key's will remain in Preserve's possession.
- Please note that locker contents are intended for offsite enjoyment and may not be consumed in the back bar, dining room, patio, or bar in accordance with Preserve's seating guidelines.
- Members are expected to abide by Preserve's internal protocols and the rules of responsible drinking in accordance with Preserve's California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Members will be held responsible for the actions of their guests, and Preserve management reserves the right to limit or refuse service based on visible signs of intoxication.
- Preserve retains the right to alter the Liquor Locker Program contract rules and Membership Benefits by providing a 15-day written notice to Members.
